

Title of your contribution to Spintech III

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Keywords: Up to 4 keywords indicating the topic of the contribution

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The abstract for Spintech III must be sufficiently informative to allow fair evaluation of the intended presentation. The text should be written in clear and concise English. The entire abstract (including title, authors, affiliation, figures and references) is restricted to one page and dimensions 5.8 inch (14.7cm) in width and 8.8 inch (22.3cm) in height. Everything exceeding these limits will be cut away during processing. Please keep an upper margin of 1.0 inch (2.5cm) and a left margin of 1.0 inch (2.5cm), but do not draw a frame.

The abstract should be typed using Times New Roman letter 10 point font for the bulk text and BLACK print only - NOT bold or italic. The line spacing should be one and a half. PDF files less than 500kB submission will be accepted. Figures are available in a PDF file. The abstract should include a title (Times New Roman letter type 18) followed by one blank line after which the authors, institutions, and e-mail address of corresponding authors are stated as shown above (Times New Roman letter type 12, authors in normal text, institutions in italic). The presenting author should be underlined. (The presenting author must register for the school and conference and present the paper by him/herself in order for the paper to be included in the Abstract Book.) A blank line should separate authors and their institutions from the keywords, which should be separated by one blank line from the bulk text. The abstract must comply with normal publication standard.[1] The bulk text should not contain paragraphs, block printing. Only the first letter of the abstract title should be written in capital letter. Abbreviations should be used for common terms only, and in brackets after the first full use of the word. Abstracts have to be sent through Web by <http://obana.issp.u-tokyo.ac.jp/spintech/> at the latest on **March 1, 2005** for the normal submission (for oral and/or poster contributions) and by June 1, 2005 for the *LATE NEWS* submission (for poster contributions only).
